Job Description

Troubleshoot, repair, and perform maintenance on customer aircraft in accordance with applicable technical data and FAA regulations.

Specific Job Duties

1. Adhere to General Work Requirements
2. Perform maintenance on customer aircraft in accordance with applicable technical data and FAA regulations
3. Perform inspection, make adjustment and repair, replace components, and correct any malfunction or deficiency with and without power applied to the aircraft
4. Access and re-install aircraft components, which obstruct the performance of assigned tasks
5. Perform mechanical and electrical removals and installations
6. Document work performed per Inspection Procedures Manual (IPM)
7. Assist with fueling/defueling aircraft as required
8. Assist Electronic/Avionics Technicians in troubleshooting and repairing aircraft
9. Assist with repairs on components detached from the aircraft, for example, flaps, ailerons, elevators, rudders, doors, and leading edges
10. Assist other employees in the performance of their duties within area(s) of qualification

Required Qualifications

- A&P license
- One (1) year aircraft electrical or mechanical system experience
- Ability to read and interpret engineering documents and repair manuals

Necessary Knowledge, Skills, & Abilities

1. Ability to use and interpret a variety of basic and precision measurement instruments
2. Basic knowledge of aircraft systems
