- Sets up and operates all available machine tools and performs progressive machining operations
- Determines and prioritizes job shop production operation sequence
- Operate 3 & 4-axis CNC lathes and mills. Currently utilizing HAAS VMCs, and HAAS Lathes.
- Interacts and coordinates with other functions (Engineering, Quality, etc.)
- Enters process performance data when required
